EAL provision and interventions	-Bi-lingual books to have home language read to at home - Visual timetable and prompt cards to support EAL children with communication - Interventions and support given to EAL children who are struggling							
SEND provision	-Children with SEN who cannot access the curriculum to attend hut club for tailored interventions -Children in class to use dual coding to support learning -TA support given where necessary -Scaffolding and resources provided to support children with additional needs							
Interventions	-Phonic interventions with the bottom 20% with each class across the whole school - Literacy volunteers to work with 2 children from each class weekly -Class teachers to do interventions during assembly time for pupil premium children and those not making enough progress -After school tutoring for identified children							
Staff CPD and induction	-2 staff meetings each term to disseminate training and practice - English lead to observe writing lessons including modelled writing and give feedback - Weekly phonics training/practice sessions by phonics lead for those involved with teaching phonics and phonic interventions - work with English hub to keep up to date with new initiatives and good practice Termly English network meetings to keep up to date with current practice and new initiatives
